History & Social Science

HIST 226 World Civilizations II (3 hours)

This course is an introductory survey of world history from 1400 to present. Through reading, lectures, discussion, and writing you will gain an elementary understanding of the sub-discipline of world history and of the major places, civilizations, events, personalities, and issues of modern world history. This course will also display how history can inform our understanding of contemporary events. (Spring)

Mathematics

MATH 131 Applied Mathematics (3 hours)

Prerequisite: SAT mathematics score of at least 500 or an ACT mathematics score of at least 21 or MATH 013 with a C- or higher or permission of the department

This course covers topics from number concepts and operations, patterns and algebra, geometry and measurement, and probability and statistics with an emphasis on problem solving in the real world. The course covers fundamental aspects of mathematics as required by the Texas Department of Education. (Spring)

Physics

PHYS 114 Physical Science (4 hours)

An introductory science course covering the fundamentals of physics, chemistry, astronomy, and earth science that will focus on hands-on activities and real-life applications. The course covers fundamental aspects of physical science as required by the Texas Department of Education. 3 Lec 3 Lab. Lab fee. (PHYS 114L) (Spring)
